Headlines like "Russia invades Ukraine," or, "Inflation surges around the world," and of course we ended the year with, "Wall Street's worst year since 2008." All headlines that don't necessarily shed the most enjoyable light on current affairs. I would much prefer to focus on the things we can control and the lives we can enhance in Minot and surrounding communities. Headlines like, "MACF grants \$1.45 million in 2022" or, "MACF surpasses \$20 million in grants since inception," are of significant note but not frequently seen in the press.

While world events, politics and other items dominated the news cycle we continue to charge forward in executing the mission of the foundation on a daily basis. We continue to actively promote charitable giving and philanthropy in Minot and surrounding communities encouraging donors to establish endowments that will make a difference well after we are gone. In 2022 we were fortunate to add 7 new permanent endowments.

Expanding a little more on our grantmaking in 2022, the Foundation made 240 grants of all sizes to organizations spanning the non-profit spectrum in Minot and surrounding communities. In fact, 2022 was the largest grant year in the history of the foundation outside of 2011 and 2012 when the Foundation led the philanthropic response to the historic flood of 2011. We are so fortunate to live in a community and region of such generosity!

Looking ahead, there are great things on the horizon for Minot and the region. Generational projects like the new Trinity Hospital campus and Magic City Discovery Center will open this year while other projects like NAWS and the new Minot North High School are set for completion in the next 12 to 18 months. At the Minot Area Community Foundation, we continue to work on new initiatives that will enhance the quality of life for all our residents, and we are proud and honored to represent our donors in those efforts.
