



Anna S. and Harold A.C. Bergstrom Scholarship Application

PURPOSE: Each year, scholarships are awarded from the Bergstrom Scholarship Fund to first-year or undergraduate students enrolled in a post-secondary educational facility. The Bergstrom Scholarship Fund offers scholarships to recipients contingent upon adequate grade point averages (2.5 or better) and desirable declared majors (agriculture and the trades), which will be verified through official transcripts. All scholarship recipients will receive funds after the successful completion of their first semester (trade schools) or first academic year (universities).

REQUIREMENTS: Applicant must be a graduating senior at Mohall - Lansford - Sherwood High School and must enroll in a post-secondary institution following high school graduation. Applicant must also be pursuing a career important to rural North Dakota. The identified careers include those in agriculture as well as the trades.
